13. Treat all players as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player.

DRESS CODE

Match Days

Players are to arrive at fixtures dressed uniformly. Appropriate apparel is:

- Club Polo Shirt
- Club Tracksuit (jacket and pants) or trousers as determined by team Management
- Runners (no sandals/thongs)
- Club Kit Bag

Grooming

It is expected that players will present themselves at all times in a neat and tidy manner. You are representatives of the brand, and the "product" that our sponsors support, and we appreciate you respecting this.



Parents' responsibilities

- We welcome your support and commitment. It is a major investment of time and money that you have made to ensure that your son enjoys his soccer experience. We will do what we can to provide a development path that helps him to his highest possible level.
- Please understand what is expected of your son by the Club, and help him fulfil his responsibilities.
- Team selection is at the coach's discretion, and he will take into account dimensions such as form, attitude, fitness, behaviour, and team balance. No player is "guaranteed" of playing time.
- Players are required to be available for all training sessions, trial, tournament, and competition matches, and may be asked to take part in other promotional activities through the year.
- Your support and encouragement is welcome, but coaching is the responsibility of the appointed coaches. At no time should a parent enter the training area during training sessions, or the dressing room or playing area before, during, or after games unless specifically invited by Rage Officials.
- Please raise any issues you have with the team Manager or Youth League Coordinator, preferably in writing. Try to avoid delay so that matters can be resolved before they escalate.
- Please be prepared to assist on match days with set-up and pack-up as needed.
- Ensure that any medical condition that requires monitoring and treatment is notified to the Club, and that proper precautions and medication are carried out and available at all times – the Club takes no responsibility for administering such treatment
- Please understand that, as a member of a select program, your son may be required to take part in promotional activities, including (but not limited to) such things as photographs being published in our website and newsletters. If you elect to "opt out" from this happening, you will need to notify the Club in writing, and we will make every reasonable attempt to comply with your wishes
